The work they completed includes English skills incorporated into their CV writing, cover letter writing and interview technique. Additional maths skills were incorporated with their business and enterprise sessions, whereby pupils developed their own business ideas and companies that culminated with pupils' enterprise schemes being put into action on results day. These activities were very successful and included bespoke memorabilia and photographs, car washing and refreshments.

A programme of team building, metacognition and discussion topics encouraged pupils and staff to self-reflect and build on their own emotional intelligence and cognitive responses to differing situations. The problem solving and confidence building continued as we researched modern art and visited a local Banksy exhibition.
